Revised Notification of (July 16 to 21, 2018)
Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course Work

- a) The Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course Work is compulsory to all provisionally registered students and the duration is of one semester. The course work is of 12 credits and the bifurcation of credits is as under:

PP-03	Guide's course based on research topic	4+0

- b) The syllabi for Pre-Ph.D. Theory Courses shall be notified on university website nmu.ac.in
- c) The candidates who have completed M. Phil. degree with course work consisting of paper on Research Methodology, will be exempted from appearing for examination & attending 6 days workshop of Pre-Ph.D. theory course work of course PP-01, i.e. Research Methodology, which he/she has completed during his/her M. Phil study. Such candidates will have to submit a request letter along with M.Phil. mark sheet & declaration certificate to Research Section.

Conduct of Pre-Ph.D. theory course work

- a) The syllabus of the Pre-Ph.D. theory course No. PP-01 i.e. Research Methodology has TWO versions, according to following faculties.
- i) Science, Engineering & Technology & Pharmacy.
- ii) Commerce & Management, Humanities, Interdisciplinary Studies.

The course work will be conducted for four different groups of faculties at different places.

- b) A 06 days workshops will be arranged for Pre-Ph.D. theory course No. PP-01, i.e. Research Methodology at North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. It is mandatory for all the research students to attend these workshops. **The venues & schedule of the workshops is as mentioned in the following table.**

The old batch students who are eligible and wish to peruse their course work during the scheduled period will have to pay Rs. 1000/- as course work examination fee by cash through challan at the university.

These workshops will start at **9'O clock in the morning & will continue till 6'O clock** in the evening everyday to cover 48 hours of teaching/contact sessions for 4 credits. Attendance shall be compulsory, otherwise certificate will not be issued.

- c) It will be the responsibility of the concerned research supervisors to teach/conduct Pre-Ph.D. theory course No.PP- 02 i.e. Subject specific course & course No. PP-03, i.e. Guide's course based on research topic, to the research students working under them.
- d) Guide will have to submit the certificate of completion of course work along with mark list of course No. PP-03 through Principal/Director of the concerned College/School to Research Section within one month after Examination of Pre-Ph.D. theory course No. PP-01 & PP-02.
- e) The provisionally allotted/admitted Ph.D. students for Ph.D. degree (irrespective of their place of research work) will have to complete Pre-Ph.D. theory course work within one year only.

Conduct & Evaluation of Pre-Ph.D. course work

- a) Tentative date of Examination of Pre-Ph.D. theory course No. PP-01 & PP-02 will be during November/December, 2018. After completion of course work workshop, other details will be communicated on University website shortly.
- b) The Examination of Pre-Ph.D. theory course No. PP-01 & PP-02 would be conducted by the University. Both courses will consist of only objective type questions.

- c) There will be no negative marking.
- d) Pre-Ph.D. theory course No. PP-03 is Guide's course based on research area, for its examination the guide should ask the student to prepare and deliver TWO seminars each of one hour duration using LCD and submit the reports. The candidate will have to write Review on research papers relevant to his/her own research topic. The weightage for each seminar will be 40 marks each & 20 marks for review article.
- e) The guide will have to submit CD's of seminar report & review article along with marks list to Research Section through the Principal/Director of the College/School on or before 30.12.2018.

The evaluation of the seminar components will be based on following four heads:

Standard of passing

The candidates are required to obtain minimum marks in Course-PP-01, PP-02 and PP-03 as given below:

Only such candidates who obtain the minimum required marks in each course, separately, as mentioned above, will be considered for final preparation of result.

For Visually Handicapped (VH) candidates 30 minutes extra time shall be provided separately for course No. PP-01 and PP-02. They will also be provided the services of a scribe who would be a graduate in a subject other than that of the candidate. Those Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates who are not in a position to write in their own hand-writing can also avail these services by making prior request (at least one week before the date of Pre-Ph.D. theory examination) in writing to the Pro-Vice Chancellor. Extra time and facility of scribe would not be provided to other Physically Handicapped candidates.

Grades for Pre-Ph.D. theory course work

Marks for each Pre-Ph.D. theory course work would be converted into grades as per 10 point scale. Students with F grade in the course shall have to clear the concerned course within six month from appearing for first time in the concerned course.
