Revised Rules of M.Sc. (Partly by Papers and Partly by Research)

(Duration : Four Years)

Eligibility Conditions :

1. No candidate shall be admitted to the M.Sc. (Partly by papers and partly by research course) of this University unless he has passed the B.Sc. Degree examination of this University or equivalent degree examination of any other Statutory University in a subject which he had offered at the B.Sc. examination.
2. A. Candidate seeking admission to the course must be an employee of the Research Institute recognised by this University or a regular employee of the other Universities/ Deemed Universities / National Laboratories (Like NCL) / R & D Units of Industries recognised by DSIR / DST.
2. B. Any other Industry (Limited / Private Limited) Personnel or institutions not covered under clause (2.A.) can be admitted, provided the place of work and the guide is either from University Departments or Institutions mentioned in Clause (2.A.)
2. C. A candidate passing the B. Sc. examination of this University or any other examination recognised as equivalent to the B.Sc. degree examination of this University and is employed as a teacher in a school within the jurisdiction of the North Maharashtra University, shall be allowed to register his / her name for the course, provided he / she finds admission in any laboratory recognised by this University, for project work.

- [Note :- The Director/Head of the Institution/ Department/ the Employer shall certify that the applicant is in regular, full-time paid service and shall remain in the service till he/she completes his/her thesis. Casual research worker/stipend holder/scholarship or fellowship holder shall not be treated as an employee for the purpose.]
- A candidate shall register his/her name for the course at the beginning of each semester-either in June or in November.
- A candidate registered for the course shall offer 4 papers prescribed for the M.Sc. (Partly by papers and partly by research) course for that subject.
- A candidate registered for the course shall be exempted from regular attendance and keeping of terms at the University.
- [Note :- Candidates registered for the course may attend the lectures conducted for the M.Sc. students. (by papers)]
- A candidate for the course shall be allowed to appear for one paper only after completing one semester. A candidate shall clear all the 4 papers at the end of the IVth semester.
- A candidate shall work for dissertation under a recognised guide from the institution where he/she is employed and is engaged in the research work. (Recognized guide means recognised for Ph.D. by North Maharashtra University or regular faculty member of University Departments from other Universities or Scientists of National Laboratories (from Scientist Grade C to F).
- A candidate shall write a thesis on a subject prescribed by the guide with the approval of the Departmental Committee chaired by Head of the University Department in the relevant subject appointed by B.C.U.D.. The material to be included in the thesis should be the work done by the candidate under the guidance of research guide, during the course of two years.
- A guide shall certify that the material included in the thesis is the work done by the student during the course of four terms kept by the student and that the material has not been published by the student before the date of his registration.

- A candidate shall submit the thesis only after passing in 4 papers and after completion of IVth semesters.
- A candidate shall submit the synopsis within a period of six months after passing in 4 papers. He/she shall submit the synopsis and thesis within a maximum period of two years after passing in 4 papers.
- No candidate shall be allowed to submit the thesis after a period of two years from passing in 4 papers unless extension is granted for submitting the thesis by B.C.U.D.
- B.C.U.D. may allow extension for submission of the thesis for a maximum period of two years after charging the normal tuition fees for one/two years as the case may be. If no such extension is granted, registration of candidates not submitting the thesis within a period of two years shall be automatically cancelled. Such a candidate shall register himself/herself for the course afresh.
- A candidate shall submit 4 copies of thesis.
- Following shall be the papers prescribed for the M.Sc. (Partly by papers and partly by research). The syllabi shall be as prescribed for the M.Sc. (by Papers).
- Theory Courses** :- The examination will be conducted by the University authorities for which the candidate has to submit examination form at each semester. Each theory course paper will carry 100 marks (after appropriate conversion from M.Sc. (Paper) pattern) The candidate is exempted from any Departmental / Internal Unit test.
- A candidate shall be deemed to have passed if he/she obtains 40% marks in the aggregate of 4 theory papers separately.
- The title & outline of the dissertation should be submitted and approved by B.C.U.D. within Six Months from the date of admission.
- Appointment of external referee (one) shall be made by B.C.U.D. from the panel recommended by the Guide and the Guide will be an internal referee of the thesis.

- An external referee shall hold Viva-Voce test of the candidate within one month from the receipt of the reports.
- The referees shall send a report within a fortnight from the date of the receipt of the thesis.
- If a referee fails to submit his report within three months from the date of a despatch of the thesis his appointment shall be cancelled and the authorities will make substitute appointment.
- The report of the referees, if unanimous, shall be final. In the event of a difference of opinion between two referees, the B.C.U.D. shall appoint a third external referee. The report of the majority of the referees shall be final.
- If the thesis is rejected, a candidate may resubmit the thesis after due revision and shall pay half the original fee for viva-voce of the thesis.
- A candidate passing the M.Sc. (partly by papers and partly by research) examination shall be declared to have passed the examination without specifying the class.
- A candidate shall pay the fees for M.Sc. (Partly by papers and partly by research) Course as per University rules.
- Admission Procedure:** Application form and the rules for admission can be down loaded from the University Web site <http://www.nmu.ac.in>. Candidate applying through internet downloaded application form should attach demand draft of Rs. 100/- drawn in favour of The Registrar, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.
- Employers Certificate must be attached to the form.
- Attested Photo Copies or relevant original documents should be attached.
- The admission will be offered only after the confirmation of Eligibility.
- The original certificates will not be returned to any candidate till verified by the University Authorities for the purpose of eligibility.

- The application form should be submitted to the Administrative Centre for Educational Department at the Main Building of the University.
- Maximum five students per subject per year will be admitted to this course only at the university departments.
- **Cancellation of admission :**
 - The candidate canceling his/her admission within a period of seven days from a date of his/her admission, deduction to the tune of 10 % of total amount of tuition fees in addition to the amount of Rs. 500/- will be made.
 - The candidate cancelling his/her admission within a period of 15 days from the date of his/her admission, deduction to the tune of 25% of total amount of tuition fees in addition to the amount of Rs. 500/- mentioned will be made.
 - The candidate cancelling his/her admission after 15 days from the date of admission, refund towards any kind of fees will not be given.

- (1) In addition, laboratory fee of Rs. 3,000/- per year for Students registered in University departments will be charged. This fee can be paid for two years. Candidates working in industries/R & D institutions (State/Central Govt.) for their project need not pay laboratory fees.
- (2) Library deposit of Rs. 1,000/- is refundable after completion of the course and be paid separately.
- (3) Viva fee of Rs. 2,500/- shall be paid before Viva-Voce.
- (4) The total fee for this course be paid for two years only.
- (5) In case of extension after four years, the normal tuition fee be paid for one/two years as the case may be.
