CIRCULAR NO. 114/2010

Sub: Rules & Information regarding Eligibility and Verification and Scrutiny of Eligibility Application Forms in respect of various courses of the University.

The eligibility certificate is the essential document for the student to get admission to the chosen course in this University jurisdiction. It is also essential that the process of issuing eligibility certificate should be completed as expeditiously as possible keeping in view the interest of students as also academics. In case such process is delayed or the process becomes faulty for any reason, it will have an adverse repercussion on the students; so much so that the money spent by students vis-à-vis their valuable year may likely to go waste for such undesirable delay in issuing eligibility certificate.

To avoid, therefore, such an eventuality and/or mitigate the same it is necessary that such process should be completed with utmost circumspection and speed. The Director of the School/Head of Department of University Department/Principal of Affiliated Colleges/Director of Recognised Institute are requested to carefully note the following instructions for this purpose.

I. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- (i) As per the decision taken by the University authorities, from the academic year 2009-10, the eligibility of students who have passed 10+2 Higher Secondary Examination from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education and seeking for F.Y.B.A., F.Y.B.Com. or F.Y.B.Sc. Class should be completed at college level through e-savidha scheme and as per rules framed by the University.

For the above, the college should collect Rs. 10/- as form fee and Rs. 50/- as Eligibility fee from each student. Out of these fees, the college should keep form fee and Rs. 10/- as processing fee from eligibility fee and should remit remaining fee Rs 40/- per student with the list of admitted students to the University office as per schedule, mentioning clearly about the **eligibility status** of each student who sought admission on the basis of 10+2 Higher Secondary Examination of Maharashtra State.

The Proposals of Eligibility along with fee of students who passed H.S.C. or Equivalent examination from a Board / University other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary education, Pune and its Divisional Boards is to be sent to the University as prescribed as per schedule given in **point no. 4**.

The eligibility of all students admitted to F.Y.B.A., B.Com. and B.Sc., Classes should be finalized at University and Colleges level up to 10th September of the Academic Year.

- (ii) Before admitting a student for a particular course the Principal of Affiliated College/Director of the Institute/Director of the School/Head of the Department should check and verify that the applicant fulfils all the conditions for eligibility to the concerned courses as per rules and regulations of the University.

- (iii) The Principal of Affiliated College/Director of the Institute/Director of the School/Head of the Department shall ensure that the student has submitted all necessary documents/certificates to the Principal/Director/Head of Department shall verify the true copies and tally them with the original ones and endorse accordingly.
- (iv) The original certificates other than Leaving Certificate of the students who passed 10+2 Higher Secondary Examination from Maharashtra State shall be retained by the respective Colleges till the end of First semester.
- (v) The student is responsible for any discrepancy / error, wrong or incomplete information given in the form. The admission authority shall ensure that the student has filled in application form completely and without any mistake.
- (vi) The Principal of Affiliated College/Director of the Institute/Director of the School/Head of the Department shall note the contents of University circulars issued, from time to time, in this behalf.
- (vii) The Principal of Affiliated College/Director of the Institute/Director of the School/Head of the Department are requested to note that the eligibility rules are strictly adhered to while giving admission to the students and after admission if any candidate is found not eligible in that event the Principal of Affiliated College/Director of the Institute/Director of the School/Head of the Department shall be held personally responsible for such lapse and is also liable for action and University office shall not be a party to any litigations arising out of such situation.
- (viii) It may please be personally and carefully seen that the students enter all the required information correctly in the prescribed eligibility form and no column in the form is left blank.
- (ix) Photocopies of the required documents in a neat and legible form with endorsements as true copies duly attested by the Principal/Head/Director or teacher-in-charge of admissions or any other person authorized in this behalf, under his signature and stamp (with date) shall be attached to the application. Certificates not attested should not be accepted. **All original documents should be returned to the concerned colleges after the completion of eligibility process.**
- (x) **In case of any dispute regarding grant of eligibility, the decision taken by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor shall be final.**
- (xi) Every year, the admissions for the courses other than centralized admissions should be completed by **15th July**. The list of admitted students should be sent to the University up to **31st July**.
- (xii) **For the students admitted after 15th July, the permission of University is essential. The students admitted without permission of University cannot be entertained.**
- (xiii) **The admissions to subsequent years like S.Y., T.Y. etc. should be made in accordance with the provisions of ordinance 67. In short, if the terms of any student have been lapsed, he should not be admitted to next higher class directly.**
- (xiv) The Eligibility of students passing 10+2 examination from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary and seeking admission for F.Y.B.A./B.Com./ B.Sc. is to be finalized by the college concern. In that case college should return original documents except leaving certificate after 15th January.

2. MIGRATION OF STUDENTS FOR ENGINEERING COURSE:

- A) The Migration of the students from one University to another University in Maharashtra for the same branch is permissible up to the Third Year of the B.E. Course, subject to the production of permission letter from the relevant Competent Authority.
- B) Admission shall not be granted to the students coming from outside the State of Maharashtra in S.E., T.E. & Final Year B.E. course.

3. ADMISSION TO UNIVERSITY SCHOOLS / DEPARTMENTS COURSES:

The student who wants to discontinue the study of Post-graduation after completion of 1st year and to study another course from different faculty, may continue the Post-graduation course after completion of the course of another faculty by following the procedure prescribed in Circular No. 112/95 issued under ref. No.NMU/95/6/9/7203, dated. 2/10/95.

4. Schedule for submission of Eligibility forms to the University.

Note

- After the specified date mentioned in column 5 above, Rs. 200/- additional late fee + Rs. 500/- as fine + eligibility fee as the case may be, will be charged. The above condition shall be applicable for 30 days prior to submission of the examination form of related course.
- It shall be the responsibility of the Principals of Colleges/Heads of Departments/Institutions that only eligible candidate is admitted to the respective Class/Course according to the eligibility conditions laid down in that behalf.
- Principal should also ensure that eligibility of every student is finalized by the University before the dates of acceptance of Examination forms or end of first term whichever is earlier.
- The course wise lists and the fees mentioning status of eligibility on the lists of students who passed 10+2 Higher Secondary Examination from Maharashtra State should be submitted up to 30th July positively otherwise the additional late fee as mentioned in note 1 above shall be charged by the University.

5. CERTIFICATES REQUIRED ALONGWITH ELIGIBILITY FORM:

- A) While sending the application form for eligibility certificate in respect of the students migrating from the jurisdiction of another University /Board, the following certificates in original along with attested Xerox copy of each shall be attached to the application :-

1) Migration Certificate 2) Attendance Certificate/Transference Certificate 3) Bonafide Certificate 4) Passing Certificate 5) Statement of Marks of the qualifying examinations 6) Degree certificate obtained at Convocation (In case of admission to Post-Graduate courses, M.Phil and courses after graduation),

- B) While deciding the eligibility of the student who passed out 10+2 Higher Secondary Examination from Maharashtra State, the College should collect following certificates in original along with attested Xerox copy of each -

1) Transference Certificate, 2) Bonafide Certificate, 3) Passing Certificate, 4) Statement of Marks.

- C) If there is a gap between the date of admission and qualifying examination, in such a case, candidate is required to submit the latest affidavit mentioning reasons of the gap.

Kindly note that in absence of any of the certificate mentioned above, final eligibility certificate will not be issued to the concerned student. The examination form of such student, whose eligibility is not finalized, will not be accepted by the University.

- D) In a rare case if the candidate is unable to furnish migration certificate along with the form, he/she should undertake to comply with before the submission of Examination form. Failing which his/her examination form will not be accepted by the University. The form for eligibility must however be sent before the last date prescribed as above.

6. SUBMISSION OF ELIGIBILITY FORMS:

- (i) The student being admitted under e-savidha scheme is not required to fill the eligibility form. However, colleges are requested to download the eligibility forms and follow the circulars and letters in this regard issued by the university from time to time.

- (ii) While forwarding the eligibility forms, the Principals/Directors are requested to arrange the forms class wise under three categories with computer CD as follows:

(a) Students joining First year other than F.Y.B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. course in the colleges affiliated to North Maharashtra University after passing the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination [12th Std.] of the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education must fill in the prescribed **WHITE FORM**.

(b) Students joining the first year various courses on the strength of passing the qualifying or equivalent examinations of other statutory Universities/ Boards must fill in the prescribed **GREEN FORM** meant for students of other Universities/Boards.

(c) Students joining the Second Year or subsequent year for various courses on the strength of passing the qualifying or equivalent examinations from the other statutory Universities must fill in the prescribed **PINK FORM** meant for students of other statutory universities.

For eligibility under category 2(ii) (a), (b) & (c) above, the attested true copies of the statement of marks and transference certificate be attached to the application form and the original statement of marks of all applicants be arranged in the same serial order of applications and be sent with list under same cover. Clarification regarding change in name if any, be given with the application itself along with valid proofs. The original migration certificate from all candidates (except candidate passing 12th std. examination

from Maharashtra State Board) should be attached to the application. The same will not be returned to the candidate.

The fees collected by the Principals/Directors should be remitted to the Registrar, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon through separate Demand Draft for categories at 2 (ii)(a), (b) and (c) above.

The applications under category 2(ii) [a], [b] & [c] should be accompanied with computerized name lists in **Three copies** in English only along with the CD as directed vide letter dated 15/7/2002. The Principal should endorse a certificate regarding check mechanism as specified in Circular No.109/ 2003 issued by the University under No. NMU/2003/6/1360,dtd.12/05/2003. Please ascertain that the eligibility forms are duly filled in completely and original certificates etc. along with attested xerox copies thereof are attached with the forms. If the attested true copies are not supplied with the application, the original certificates will be kept in the University office for record and University office will not be responsible if original certificates are misplaced. After finalization of eligibility, the college representative should collect immediately the entire original records of the students.

The Principals/Heads are requested to co-operate in ensuring that no irregular admissions are granted as the University may not be in a position to rectify the irregular admissions under any circumstances.

7. READMISSION UNDER e-SUVIDHA SCHEME.

The students who have taken readmission to the courses under e-Suvidha scheme have to go through all process of e-Suvidha scheme.

College should send separate proposal with necessary fees to University as intimate vide Circular No. **157/2004 dated 4th August 2004.**

8. FEES:

a) The eligibility fees should be amended from academic year 2008-2009 as follows;

- b) A Foreign National Student passing the qualifying Examination from the Statutory Board/University in India should be admitted directly subject to the production of passport, visa and entrance fee of US \$ 100 and medical certificate. The Passport visa & Medical Certificate & Entrance Fee US \$ 100 be sent to this University office along with the eligibility form. The student must fill in the prescribed form meant the foreign student for the eligibility.
- c) The foreign students mentioned in b) above, shall have to pay eligibility fee as prescribed by the university from time to time.

9. **ADMISSION TO FOREIGN STUDENTS:**

Principals of Colleges/Director of institutions are requested to send admission proposal of foreign students to the Director of B.C.U.D. along with required documents as stated below.

I. **VISA :**

- a) As per the directives of the Government of India, Ministry of Education, New Delhi, no self supporting foreign student be admitted or allowed to continue in the college without a student visa.
- b) **A foreign National Student passing** Higher Secondary Examination [XIIth Std.] of Maharashtra State should not be admitted directly to any course by the College /Institution without a student visa.

II. The students other than nominated students possessing foreign qualifications, who intend to seek admission to academic/professional courses at Colleges, may be advised to obtain EQUIVALENCE CERTIFICATE from Association of Indian Universities to facilitate their admission. They should provide the following information to the Association of Indian Universities, AIU House, 16 Kotla Marg, New Delhi-110 002 for obtaining Equivalence Certificate.

- a) Degree/Diploma certificate together with year wise academic transcript/mark sheet duly authenticated by Indian Mission abroad/concerned Foreign Mission in India.
- b) Accreditation status of the degree awarding foreign University/Authority.
- c) A Bank draft of US \$ 50 or equivalent Indian currency in favor of Secretary General, Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi as fee.

III. **CERTIFICATES REQUIRED ALONGWITH FOREIGN STUDENTS' ELIGIBILITY FORMS:**

Following certificates in original along with attested Xerox copy of each shall be attached;

1. Permission letter of Board of College & University Development Section of the University.(BCUD Section)
2. Degree Certificate
3. Marks statements
4. Migration Certificate from the last University
5. Visa
6. Medical Fitness Certificate of MD doctor
7. AIU (Association of Indian Universities)Equivalence Certificate
8. Police verification report
9. Attested copy of mark statement and transcript (original)
10. No objection form Indian Embassy.
11. Blood Test Report from National Institute of Virology, Pune-1.

IV. **ELIGIBILITY FEE FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS;**

Eligibility fee shall be charged from foreign students as under:

1. For under-graduate courses Rs. 10,000/-
2. For post-graduate courses Rs. 20,000/-

The fees collected by the Principal / Director should be remitted to the Registrar, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon through separate demand draft.

V. **MEDICAL CERTIFICATE AND ENTRANCE TEST :**

The student coming from Commonwealth Countries are not required to produce student visa. Admission letter will be issued only to the fresh foreign students excluding the foreign students migrating from Indian Universities. A foreign student will be issued a letter of eligibility/ admission only on receiving certificate of

blood test from National Institute of Virology Pune-1 and a certificate of medical fitness. Foreign students who are joining the University after passing the Examination from any statutory Universities in India will have to pay fee US Dollars 100 (One hundred U.S. Dollars) per student. A fresh foreign candidate is required to submit his eligibility form on or before 10th May of the year.

VI. INFORMATION FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS :

All degree or Diploma Examinations from Foreign Countries have not been given general recognition for admission to any of the course of this University.

After admissions of all the foreign students are over, Principals/ Directors/ Heads are requested to send to eligibility section, a country wise list of fresh foreign students mentioning therein eligibility case No. and the course for the relevant academic year. **Foreign students should not be admitted to any of the Management and Technical courses or to any course from the Faculties of Engineering without prior approval of the Government of India, New Delhi as well as University.**

No Nigerian student be admitted to any college without the approval of C.B.N.

The Principals of colleges should not give any admission to any Iraqi student to any course of study until they receive a recommendation of the Embassy of the Republic of Iraq, or the Ministry of Education and culture, Government of India, New Delhi.

10. ADMISSION IN ANTICIPATION OF RESULTS:

The Principals of the colleges are requested not to admit any student in anticipation of their examination results.

11. RECOGNITION OF DEGREES AND DIPLOMAS:

The University has decided that all the Degrees and Diplomas awarded by the Statutory Universities in India be recognized for the purpose of admission to higher courses on reciprocal basis.

Mere eligibility, however, does not confer a right of admission to the course and it is left to the Principal of college/Institute to decide whether a candidate is to be granted admission or otherwise. If such permission is granted by the university on the recommendation of the Principal, the student is required to keep term for the specific subject & has to appear for examination as additional as prescribed by the University.

12. ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR OTHER UNIVERSITY STUDENTS:

- I. The students who have passed their First year B.A./B.Com/B.Sc. level examination either from outside the jurisdiction of North Maharashtra University or from outside the State of Maharashtra cannot be admitted directly in the next higher class without prior approval of this University. (Refer circular No. 71/1995 issued under No. NMU/95/8/1/2081 dated 27/4/1995) .

13. INFORMATION REGARDING ADMISSIONS:

A list of students whose eligibility forms are submitted to the University for Eligibility Certificate but did not join or after joining the course for a short period discontinued the course during First term should be forwarded to the University on 30th September every year. No transference certificate should be issued in their favour unless final eligibility certificate is issued by the University office.

14. CHANGE IN NAME:

It shall be ensured that name of the student in the application form for eligibility and statement of marks, passing certificate, Degree certificate of the qualifying examination or in any other document enclosed therewith is the same. If there is a difference in the name proof for a change in the name, such as copy of Government Gazette or Marriage Registration Certificate & Affidavit should be enclosed along with the application form. Eligibility certificate shall not be issued in absence of such documentary proof.

No change in name should be made after finalization of the eligibility of the students

15. REGARDING PRIVATE / EXTERNAL STUDENT'S ADMISSION:

The candidate registered by other Universities/ Boards as an External/ Private student shall not be allowed to join college for next subsequent higher class/ semester. It is, therefore, necessary for a student to produce bonafide certificate of qualifying Examination from College/ Institution, last attended by him as a regular student, if he desires to seek admission as a regular student.

However, the students who have passed XIIth std. examination of Maharashtra State Board, by filling **Form No.17** are eligible for admission to any course taking into consideration the eligibility rules prescribed in Para 34 of this circular.

The students who have passed the F.Y./S.Y. examination in any faculty as external/Private student are not eligible for any higher class admission in this university (Refer circular No. 70/1995 issued vide no. NMU/95/6/8/2031, dated 24/04/1995).

16. A.T.K.T. STUDENTS FROM OTHER UNIVERSITIES:

Unsuccessful students, at the Higher Secondary Examination [**12 years course**] and the Intermediate Examination of Statutory Boards should not be admitted in anticipation that they would pass at the Compartmental/ Supplementary Examination. Students getting A.T.K.T. Concession from any Statutory University in India may not be admitted to Higher Class.

17. A.T.K.T. AT PRE DEGREE:

The students who have obtained A.T.P.T./A.T.K.T./Supplementary at the Pre/Degree Arts, Science and Commerce, examination from any University including Poona University are not eligible for admission to any course in this University.

18. CASES OF FAILURES FROM OTHER UNIVERSITIES:

Students who have failed at the Intermediate Arts/Intermediate Science/Intermediate Commerce or B.A. Part-I/ B.Com. Part-I/B.Sc. Part-I examination of other Universities should not be admitted to the same class unless it is confirmed that such students have passed the lower qualifying examination.

19. S.S.C. WITH GOVERNMENT COMMERCIAL DIPLOMA (G.C.D.):

Students passing the S.S.C. examination with English and Government Commercial Diploma Examination of the Government of Maharashtra are not eligible for admission to the F.Y. course.

20. ADMISSIONS TO THE STUDENTS WHO ARE IN SERVICE:

Almost all courses in the University are full time courses. Therefore students who are in service, should not be admitted as a regular student directly. Therefore Admission Authority should ensure that no such students be admitted. Before giving such admissions the Principal of the College should furnish following documents to the University and obtain approval.

1. Permission letter from the concerned Employer
2. Certificate regarding duty time and working hours.
3. Time table of the Class / Course.
4. Leave sanction order if any from the concerned employer.

21. ADMISSION TO NEXT HIGHER CLASS TO THE STUDENTS WHO HAVE PASSED THE LOWER EXAMINATION FROM ANY OTHER UNIVERSITY:

- 1) The students who have passed the FYBA/B.Com/B.Sc. examination from any other University including Poona University should not be directly admitted to the next higher class. Such students are required to submit the application through the Principal of the college, in the proforma prescribed therefore by the University. Such students are also required to submit an undertaking countersigned by the Principal regarding the passing of additional subjects, if any, according to the syllabus of North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon.
- 2) The students who have passed SYBA/B.Com/B.Sc. examination from any other statutory University including Poona University should not be directly admitted to the next Higher class, till the receipt of the permission from the University. Such students are also required to give any additional subjects prescribed by the University. Such students are also not eligible for award of class or Degree certificate.
The procedure should strictly be followed according to the circular, issued in this behalf.
- 3) Such students are required to submit photocopy of Permission along-with the eligibility form.

22. NON ELIGIBILITY:

- i) The students who have passed one year (one sitting) or two years degree examination from any other Statutory University are not eligible for admission to any Master's Degree programme.
- ii) Students passing the Higher Secondary Examination of which duration is 11 years any Board (the duration of which is 11 years) is not eligible for admission to the First Year of the Three years Degree Course. Such students are **not** eligible for admission to other courses also where H.S.C.(XII) or equivalent examination is the minimum qualification.
- iii) Students passing the Higher Secondary Examination from Bhartiya Shiksha Parishad, Lucknow, and Uttar Pradesh are not eligible for admission to the First Year of Three Years Degree Course.
- iv) Students passing the School level Examination conducted by the following Boards should **not** be admitted to any course in this University.
 - 1) The Central Board of Higher Education, Tilak Nagar, New Delhi-110 018.
 - 2) The Central Board of Higher Education, 39/7 East Patel Nagar, New Delhi.
 - 3) The Central Board of Higher Education, Vachaspati Bhavan, New Delhi.
- v) Students passing Higher Secondary (**XI Std.**) Examination from Rajasthan Board/M.P. Board, Bhopal are not eligible for admission to any course.
- vi) Students who have passed the Degree Examination from Dnyaneshwar Vidyapeeth, Pune are **not** eligible for admission to Post-Graduate Course in any faculty.
- vii) The courses taught by the University/Institutes not listed by the UGC/ AIU, New Delhi shall not be considered for eligibility.
- viii) Art Teacher Diploma: The candidate who has passed Art Teacher Diploma is **not** eligible for B.A., B.Com., B.Sc. courses.
- ix) All India senior school certificate exams, New Delhi:
The candidate who has passed the All India Senior School Certificate Examination, New Delhi in compartment is **not** eligible for any admission in the next higher class under this university area.

23. INTERMEDIATE EXAMINATION OF ANDHRA PRADESH:

The Candidates passing Intermediate examination with subject English from the Board of Intermediate Education Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad and the Uttar Pradesh Board, Allahabad, should be admitted only for the first year of the Three Year Degree Course according to the subjects offered at the Intermediate examination.

24. INTERMEDIATE ARTS, COMMERCE AND SCIENCE - FROM M.P. BOARD, BHOPAL AND BIHAR STATE

- a) Students who have passed the Intermediate Arts or Commerce or Science Examination from the Board of Secondary Education M.P., Bhopal and Bihar Board with four subjects including General English may be admitted to the F.Y.B.A./F.Y.B.Com. Course respectively.
- b) Students who have passed the Intermediate Science examination with Compulsory English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology /Mathematics from the Board of Secondary Education, M.P. Board Bhopal and Bihar Board are eligible for admission to F.Y.B.Sc. Course provided the examination is passed as regular candidate.

25. PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF ELIGIBILITY FORMS:

The Principals /Directors/Heads are requested to send the eligibility forms faculty wise separate along with all certificates required as per rules so as to reach the University on or before the dates mentioned above. They are further requested to send the fees through Nationalized Banks demand draft only. It may be noted that cheques will not be accepted under any circumstances. Application forms not accompanied by Nationalized Bank's Demand Draft will not be accepted and late fee will be charged to the concerned Colleges. The application forms with fee for certificates of eligibility should be submitted to the college by the students at the time of admission and college should send all the applications with separate demand draft of fees collected from students as per category 2(a), (b) & (c) mentioned earlier and so as to reach the University on or before the dates mentioned above.

26. The Principals of affiliated Colleges, Directors of recognized institutes/Directors of University Schools/Heads of University Departments are earnestly requested to ensure that admissions are given strictly in accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the University. If the Colleges/Institutes have any difficulty while deciding the eligibility of any candidate for admission to any course, they should refer the case to the University along with all originals and certified copies of the certificates.

27. The circulars issued from time to time previously or will be issued in future regarding eligibility are also applicable.

28. The Principals are requested to note that no irregular admission will be rectified under any circumstances.
